

Community Development Grant Workshop



Rise, formerly Regional Housing and Community Development Alliance (“RHCD”), is officially underway with its 2014 CDC Capacity Building and Collaborative Grant Program application funding cycle.

This grant workshop is for St. Louis area Community Development Corporations (CDCs) serving St. Louis County, the City of St. Louis, Madison and St. Clair County, IL, that may seek to apply for a 2014 Rise Collaborative Grant. It is not required but it is strongly encouraged that eligible CDCs from these jurisdictions attend the workshop. There have been substantial changes to Rise’s Collaborative Grant application process.

The workshop will also help CDCs learn before they apply for other grants what their organization’s obligations and requirements will be to manage and report on their proposed activity if it is funded. Because there is strong competition for funding sources, performance counts. Therefore this workshop will provide invaluable training on the grant application process as well as the requirements of receiving grants. These topics will include:

- Getting Prepared for a Grant: How to make sure that your organization is ready to accept grant funds
- Expectations of Grantees: What it takes to be a successful grantee
- Effectively Communicating the Activity Proposed: Identifying and linking outputs as well as projecting and measuring outcomes for grant performance and effectiveness
